His primary creative endeavour is as part of the new Irish music and poetry collective: ReGroovonation, where he acts as arranger, orchestrator, writer, and keyboardist; their debut show 'In An Age of Insecurity' (a narrative, genre-blending musically-theatrical piece) which featured over 20 performers, including actors, singers, dancers, rappers, and a chamber orchestra, premiered in April in the Bello Bar and is due to be staged again in Dublin 2018.

He works mainly as an accompanist, teacher, conductor, performer and freelance composer and is based in Trim, Co. Meath.
